

## **Two new species of *Dysmachus* Loew, 1860 (Asilidae: Diptera) from Turkey**

### **ABSTRACT**

Two new species of *Dysmachus* Loew, 1860 are described from Turkey and illustrated. *D. suludereae* n. sp. is related to *D. ornatus* Theodor, 1980, characterised by the posterior lobes on the hind margin of sternite 8 in males. *D. safranboluticus* n. sp. is related to *D. obtusus* Becker, 1923, characterized by the shape of epandrium.

### **INTRODUCTION**

This study is based on specimens collected from the Turkish provinces Isparta, Burdur, Afyon, and Zonguldak from 1992-1995. The comparison with the descriptions of the other known species of the genus *Dysmachus* Loew, 1860 (Adamovi<sup>o</sup> 1977, Efflatoun 1934, Engel 1926-1930, Lehr 1966 & 1996, Oldroyd 1958, Richter 1962a & 1962b & 1968 & 1973, Séguy 1926, Theodor 1980, Weinberg 1968) shows that they are new species which are described herewith.
