

## **New and Rare Taxa of Ichneumonidae (Hymenoptera) from Turkey**

### **ABSTRACT**

One subfamily, six genera and seven species of various subfamilies of Ichneumonidae are discovered from Turkey for the first time. New data on distribution of the species are provided and for each species a chorotype classification is given.

### **INTRODUCTION**

Serial studies have been conducted on the family Ichneumonidae fauna of East Anatolia by the authors since 1996 (Kolarov and Özbek, 1998; Kolarov et al., 1999 & 2000; Özbek et al., 2000; Pekel and Özbek, 2000). This present is study based upon the materials collected recently in Erzurum Ardahan and Kars provinces. The specimens are deposited in the Entomology Museum, Erzurum, Turkey (EMET) and the collection of J. Kolarov (JK).

### **RESULTS**

Eight ichneumonid species are found. Of these seven species (marked by asterisks), the subfamily Collocerinae itself and the genera *Strongylopsis* Brauns, *Scolobates* Gravenhorst, *Spudaeus* Gistel, *Cylloceria* Schiodte, *Megastylus* Schiodte and *Barycnemis* Foerster are new for the fauna of Turkey.
